

Description: This phenomenon, a sort of social bullying may not come as a surprise to many senior center staff or senior living facility staff,

but if we understood some of the reasons the behavior occurs we could learn strategies to prevent and address the issues. Social manipulation and exclusion seem to have more to do with acquiring power, a feeling of control at a point in life when older adults can feel powerless. Dementia can also play a role when senior bullying is occurring.
